- 1 Use multiple textbooks and grammars  
Choose your own textbooks  
Two or more textbooks  
Agatha Christie or Harry Potter books  
Comic books like Tintin  
Joke books
- 2 Make your own survival course. Use the Transparent Language/Nodtronics Eureka Introductory course to get started.
- 3 Learn songs, download the lyrics from the Internet.
- 4 Learn the language in two “waves”.  
Quickly but poorly is better than slowly but surely. Don’t worry if some vocabulary falls through the cracks.
- 5 Utilize “lost time.”
- 6 Have immersion days or mini days.
- 7 Play with the language—don’t work at learning it.
- 8 Use the Internet—there are whole courses available for some languages.
- 9 Use the methods to learn your vocabulary
- 10 Watch movies in the language or DVD’s with sub-titles in your target language.
- 11 Play with language computer games for kids
- 12 Use a recorded language program for oral/aural practice. Choose one recorded entirely in your target language
